GUIDELINES FOR ANM, GNM, POST CERTIFICATE DIPLOMA COURSES AND L.H.V. PROGRAMME TO BE CONDUCTED IN A.Y. 2018-19.

A) General Instruction

- The academic year for ANM, GNM, post certificate courses, LHV. PHN will commence from <u>1st August</u>, every year.
- 2. The admitted students should be enrolled online from 1st August 2018 to 30th August 2018. No any extension in date of admission will be granted. The username and password should be preserved by a permanent responsible staff of your school.
- 3. The admission enrollment will be physically verified in the office of the MSBNPE on the basis of prior fixed appointment. The appointment dates of all the nursing institutions will be displayed on MSBNPE website on 10 August, 2018. The Principal of the respective college will report to the MSBNPE office for the same. Admission will be considered valid only after approval from MSBNPE.
- 4. Teaching (A) Staff Principal & all appointed teachers should be eligible, qualified, experienced as per norms & registered with MNC before their appointment.(B) 1:10 teacher: students ratio should be maintained. (C) Tutors should not leave the institutions during the academic year.
- 5. The authorities of the institutions should not admit Male candidates more than 30% of the sanctioned intake of the students per year.
- 6. Do not admit underage & overage students.(See B-1 & 2 and C-1 and C-2)
- 7. Check MSBNPE website www.msbnpe.org frequently.
- 8. Maintain all the records and reports as per the norms of this programme.
- Submit the clinical permission letter of affiliated hospital, Urban Public Health and Rural Public Health posting for A.Y.2018-19 before 30th August, 2018 as a prerequisite for online admission enrollment. Students should be given Urban & Rural Community Health experience.
- 10. For ANM, GNM, there should be at least 10 candidates in the batch else the batch will not be permitted for the MSBNPE examination.
- 11. For Post certificate courses, LHV, PHN, there should be at least 50% candidates admitted for the course as per the intake strength sanctioned by MSBNPE.
- 12. Every institution should pay yearly Bed Affiliation Fees on or before 31st March by NEFT for next academic year. Thereafter penalty of Rs.100/- per day will be charged.

- 13. Inspection fees if due should be paid on or before 31st March by NEFT
- 14. Any issues regarding the Exam should be personally brought to the notice of the MSBNPE two months prior to the examination date.
- 15. Marksheet issues will not be entertained during the months of exam.
- 16. Carefully mention the gender titles against the male and female candidates. No alteration/ changes will be permitted by of this office after enrollment.
- 17. Student patient ratio of 1:3 should be maintained.
- 18. For Oral Practical examination, one examiner should compulsory be female with minimum 3 years teaching experience.
- 19. For examination, candidates seat numbers will be uploaded on MSBNPE website. After allotment of seat numbers, you have to complete the online internal assessment marks as per guidelines of exam department. Otherwise MSBNPE will not be able to issue Hall Tickets to the candidates. The internal assessment marks should be entered term wise as per instruction from Examination Department.
- 20. During admission, enrollment student's passport size photograph (2"X2") should be scanned and uploaded, so that the photos can be printed on hall tickets.

B) ANM

- 1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- 2. The maximum age of admission shall be 35 years.
- 3.The minimum educational requirements shall be 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studied, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/ English Elective or Science or Health Care Science Vocational stream ONLY passing out from recognized Board.
- 4.Student shall be medically fit.
- 5.Students qualified in 10+2 Arts, Commerce or Science examination conducted by National Institute of Open School.
- 6.Student shall be admitted once in a year.

C) GNM

- 1. The Minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year which admission is sought.
- 2. The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
- There is no age bar for ANM/ LHV.
- 4. Minimum education:
- 10+2 class passed preferable Science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.
- 10+2 in (Mathematics, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy) and English Core/ English Elective or Health Care Science - Vocational

- under Board recognized AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board with 40% marks.
- o 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE Board or other equivalent board from the school and recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% marks.
- Registered as ANM with State Nursing Council. If application is for admission through ANM quota
- 5. Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science or Commerce examination or Health Care Science - Vocational stream ONLY conducted by National Institute of Open School with 40% marks.
 - 6. Student shall be medically fit.
 - 7. Student shall be admitted once in a year.
